PONY Baseball and Softball is proud to announce an Alumni Scholarship for graduates of Pony League, Colt League and/or Palomino League. In order to be considered for a scholarship a PONY baseball or softball player must play on a PONY affiliated Pony, Colt and/or Palomino team for at least two years prior to application and be a senior in high school. Likewise an application must be submitted prior to the stated deadline along with the School & Community Activities Form, an Essay on the designated topic, an Official Secondary School Transcript, a copy of the Letter of Acceptance from the school you are planning to attend, a Notarized Letter confirming participation in an affiliated league and two Letters of Recommendation. When the aforementioned information has been received, the Scholarship Committee will consider the application complete.

The Scholarship Committee will administer four scholarships annually, one each to the four United States zones (north, east, south, west) of PONY Baseball and Softball.

1. The Application for the scholarship signed and dated by both the applicant and their High School Guidance Counselor.
2. The School & Community Activities Form.
3. The Essay (100 words or less).
4. An Official Secondary School Transcript.
5. A copy of the Letter of Acceptance from the school you are planning to attend.
6. A Notarized Letter from the League President of the PONY affiliated Baseball or Softball League confirming the applicant's participation for a minimum of two years in Pony League, Colt League and/or Palomino League.
7. Two Letters of Recommendation.
